## The GOSHA 2010 Health & Safety Awards

The awards are independently judged by senior members of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health – Thames Valley branch, and are pre-sented at the annual GOSHA Awards Dinner on 11th November 2010.

### Recognising individuals and teams

For the first time in 2010, we are also introducing an individual category within the awards. Organisations may like to nominate an individual or team who have shown particular commitment in reducing accidents within their workplace.

### What is GOSHA?

GOSHA is a voluntary, non-profit making organisation, set up in November 2004 to support businesses and other organisations in Guernsey by encouraging best practice in occupational safety and health, helping mem-bers develop professional standards within their sphere of work, providing a forum for discussion and sharing information, developing a network for those with responsibilities for occupational health and safety, organising presentations by experts in relevant subjects or topics of interest, provid-ing workshops on topical issues as well as working closely with the Health and Safety Inspectorate, professional consultancies and other occupa-tional safety and health associations.

### How to make a nomination

Interested organisations should contact GOSHA with a short outline of why an award should be made, along with a short description of your organisation. Contact details of a person within your organisation should also be provided. A member of the awards team will then contact you to gather further information. The deadline for nominations is 20th September 2010.
